Scholarship Eligibility & Criteria

✓ Financial Need Eligibility:

- ☐ Applicant must file a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

✓ Applicant Eligibility:

(must meet at least one of the following criteria):

- ☐ Age 25 or older.
- ☐ Returning to school after 3+ years.
- ☐ Single parent with dependent children.
- ☐ Military affiliated (active duty, veteran, spouse, or dependent).
- ☐ Former foster youth.

✓ Applicant Requirements:

- ☐ Maintain a 3.0+ college GPA.
- ☐ Be a resident of Arizona, Colorado, Idaho, Iowa, Nevada, or Utah and meet all in-state residency requirements for the college of attendance.
- ☐ Be a part-time or full-time student.
- ☐ Complete the FAFSA (annually).
- ☐ Have a goal of earning a bachelor's degree within 8 semesters or an associate's degree within 4 semesters
- ☐ Major in an approved degree (see CTA Approved Majors).

✓ Selection Criteria:

We are looking for students who demonstrate:

- ☐ Outstanding character and a strong work ethic.
- ☐ Leadership potential through community activities.
- ☐ Commitment to educational success as reflected by GPA, coursework, and major selection.
- ☐ An ability to clearly communicate both verbally and in writing.

\$ Scholarship Amount:

- ☐ Award Amount not to exceed \$25,000 annually.
- ☐ Cost of Attendance (COA) – Student Aid Index (SAI) – other aid = Award Amount.
